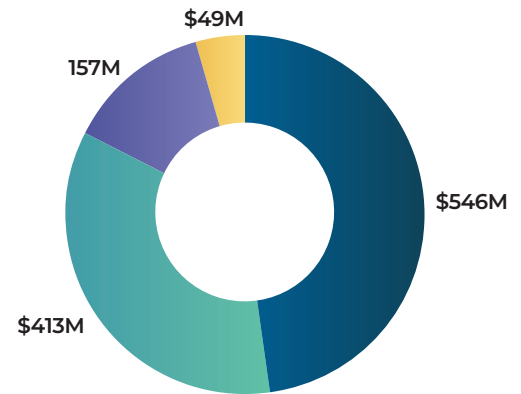

Opening More Doors to Kids

New Clinics in Mexico

Shriners Children's™ has expanded its reach in Mexico. In addition to its hospital in Mexico City, Shriners Children's™ now has outpatient clinics in Tijuana, Monterrey, Culiacan and Guadalajara. A fifth clinic in the city of Chihuahua is also underway. Adding new access points of care is part of Shriners Children's international strategy to care for more children in the right places, closer to their homes.



Shriners Children's Texas Expansion

In a significant milestone, Shriners Children's Texas has opened a new, 40-unit housing facility and parking garage. Shriners Children's Texas' physicians and staff are highly specialized in burn care, orthopedic conditions, complex skin conditions and plastic and reconstructive surgery. This expansion enables the hospital to better serve a growing patient population.

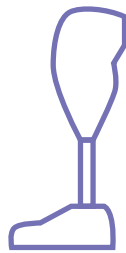

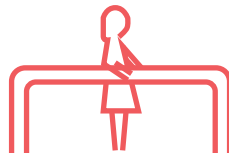

Unforgettable Experiences

Shriners Children's camps give patients a sense of belonging

Special programs at Shriners Children's™ help children enjoy tackling challenges in environments where they'll be safe, gain confidence and independence, and can make friends and memories that last a lifetime.

Camp Fez

"Campers are provided an opportunity to build independence during manageable daily life challenges in a nurturing camp environment with a counselor and peer support," says Beth English, a certified therapeutic recreational therapist at Shriners Children's and an organizer of Camp Fez.

FLOW

Recreation therapy is fun with a purpose at FLOW (Friendship, Leisure, Opportunity and Wellness). Programming includes sports, social activities and art to increase self-esteem and social skills; promote rule following; and increase strength, endurance, flexibility, balance and coordination.

You help provide children with the opportunities to reach their dreams and live without limits.

Other camps organized by Shriners Children's include:

Camp Winning Hands

A weeklong, overnight camp for kids with hand differences or upper extremity differences.

Camp Ytiliba

An overnight camp established in 1990 for children who sustained a burn injury. "Ytiliba" spelled backwards is "Ability," which is emphasized for each camper.

Un-Limb-ited Camps

These camps support our teen patients who are living with limb loss or limb deficiency.

Camp Achieve

A three-day day camp where campers are able to interact with other children who have a limb deficiency while participating in adventure activities and challenges.



Burn Care from Bench to Bedside

When she was just 2 years old, Zoey arrived at Shriners Children's™ after sustaining scald injuries while helping her mother cook macaroni and cheese. It was a frightening time for the family, but the Shriners Children's staff was able to quickly develop a plan. Zoey received skin grafts on her arms, shoulders and back. But the family received even more: compassion. Staff made sure the hospital felt like Zoey's second home, stocking her room with her favorite books, toys and bubbles.

Her treatment continues one year later, and she visits Shriners Children's every other month for follow-up with physical therapy and her physicians. But perhaps more importantly, Zoey is back to the activities she loves, including soccer and gymnastics.

Legacy of Innovation

Shriners Children's scientists and healthcare professionals continually pursue advancements in care for children through innovative research. The Howard Green Center for Children's Skin Health and Research is core to a robust research program. The Center was made possible by the generosity of Rosine Kauffmann Green in honor of her husband, pioneering physician and researcher Dr. Howard Green.

Dr. Green was a pioneer in regenerative medicine, and the first to grow skin grafts using a patient's own cells. The first grafts from cultured skin were used to treat patients at Shriners Children's Boston in the early 1980s. Today, the Center continues to innovate, with researchers like Green Center Investigator Dr. Osman Berk Usta exploring new technologies for skin wound care that may reduce the physical and psychological burdens of burn care.

Helping Create the Latest Technology to Change Lives

Motion Analysis labs use technology, including motion sensors, infrared cameras and computers, to better treat patients with cerebral palsy (CP) and orthopedic conditions. In addition to individualized treatment plans, the data gathered enables us to gain greater understanding of the orthopedic and neuromuscular conditions we treat. We're applying this anonymized data to our own research, as well as research partners. Together, we'll develop more advanced treatments for conditions like scoliosis, cerebral palsy, spina bifida, muscular dystrophy, osteogenesis imperfecta (brittle bones) and foot deformities.

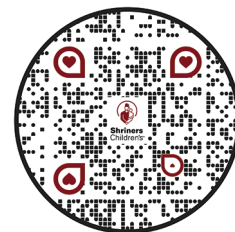
A Community Comes Together to Give Back

At just 10 years old, Zoey inspired her community to give back to Shriners Children's™.

Zoey, a patient at Shriners Children's, was born with a rare spinal condition. At birth, doctors did not think she would be able to walk on her own — but today, she's standing tall, helping her parents on the family farm and pursuing her passion of caring for animals.

Included in her daily chores is care of cattle. In the fall of 2023, Zoey's steer, Fire, was sold at auction at her local county fair for over \$16,000. Her grandfather canvassed the community for support, growing the number to just over \$18,000. The proceeds were all donated to Shriners Children's.

Lucia's Story

When asked why she supports Shriners Children's™, Lucia recalls a specific memory from years ago. She and her mother were sitting in church alongside a little girl and her father who survived a devastating car crash while vacationing in Spain. The accident had left them both with burns all over their bodies. A little boy sitting behind them caught a glimpse of the girl and recoiled in shock, commenting on her appearance to his mother.

Lucia said that moment affected her deeply.

She felt called to find a way to help young children who have been through similar accidents. Through a friend, she learned about Shriners Children's. She toured a Shriners Children's facility and met patients, noting the activities and resources tailored to ensure that kids have a positive healthcare experience. Lucia made her first contribution more than two decades ago and continues to give, now using charitable



gift annuities (CGAs) and charitable remainder unitrusts (CRUTS) to support our healthcare system.

"It's important to me that the majority of the money I donate goes directly to the kids,"
shared Lucia.

If you are age 70½ or older, you may make tax-free charitable gifts of up to \$100,000/year directly from your Individual Retirement Accounts.

Donor-Advised Funds

A donor-advised fund (DAF), which is like a charitable savings account, gives you the flexibility to recommend how much and how often money is granted to Shriners Children's and other qualified charities.

Gifts of Appreciated Assets

Shriners Children's gratefully accepts gifts in the form of stocks and appreciated securities. There are no capital gains taxes to be paid and, if you itemize deductions on your tax return, you may be able to claim the full appreciated amount as a charitable deduction up to 30% of your adjusted gross income.
