

What Does It Mean To Be A Team Captain?




As a Team Captain, your primary responsibilities are to:

- **Set a goal** to recruit at least fifteen co-workers, friends and family members to register for the event and join your team. There is no limit to the size of your team!
- **Use our Online Fundraising Tools** to create your own Team Page, send personal emails to recruit Team Members and raise funds and track online donations.
- **Encourage your Team Members** to use our Online Fundraising Tools. Ask them to set up their Personal Fundraising Pages and send emails to their co-workers, friends and family members to raise funds.
- **Send regular updates** to Team Members and encourage them to set and surpass their fundraising goals. Remind them of the fun swag they can score when they hit their goals!
- Share fundraising tips and team progress with your Team Members.
- Schedule training meet ups and a team kick off. Make sure to take pictures and tag #WFLSLC2023 leading up to the day of event.
- Ask your Team Members to give you any offline donations (cash and checks) and then send them into your local hospital's Development Department.

Create Your Team Page






Team Captain Timeline

Mark your calendar, follow these steps and get ready for success!



- Register your team
- Build a Team and Personal Fundraising Page
- Set your Team Goals
- Begin recruiting team members
 via email, phonecalls, and letters
- Find out your company's Matching Gift policy

4-8 Weeks Prior to the Walk

- Hold a Team Kickoff Party
- Continue recruiting Team
 Members
- Remind your Team Members of the event's money turn-in deadlines to receive incentives
- Email your Team with important event updates and information
- Begin collecting donations it's never too early to get started!

2-4 Weeks Prior to the Walk

- Host a Team Fundraiser Silent Auction, Bake Sale, Garage Sale, etc.
- Email your Team with weekly incentives and updates
- Be sure your Team Members are registered!



One Week Prior to the Walk

- Check to make sure you have all of the walk routes, maps and apps downloaded (if applicable), etc.
- Keep encouraging your
 Teammates to fundraise and train

Two-One Days Prior to the Walk

Remind your Team about the fun and festivities, location, any guidelines they will need to follow, etc.



Day of Walk

- Meet your Team at the designated location
- Turn in additional pledges
- Take a Team picture and post on social media with #WFLSLC2023
- Enjoy the day and celebrate the difference you are making!

Post-Walk

Collect and turn in additional pledges



- Congratulate and thank Team
 Members for their hard work
- Host a Thank You wrap-up party and recognize top Team Members
- Start planning for next year!
